Position Purpose

Provide preventive health services to facilitate the student's physical, mental, emotional and social growth and development.

Key Accountabilities

Function

- Integrates knowledge, skills, and clinical experience to meet the needs of the high school students, their families, and the community
- Provides individualized patient education
- Utilizes standards and guidelines for care delivery
- Serves as clinical resource and mentor
- Works closely with the Director of Nursing, Director of Counseling and nursing staff in the Health and Wellness Center
- Works closely with Dean of Students Office as part of the Student Life Department to teach topics related to health and wellness
- Coordinates care for students with outside medical professionals

Requirements

- Registered Nurse in Virginia or multi-state privilege
- CPR Certified
- Pediatric/Triage experience
- Valid driver's license

Miscellaneous

- Regular weekday shifts and weeknight on-call shifts (as determined by the Director of Nursing)
- Weekend hours and weekend on-call duty (as determined by the Director of Nursing) while students/campers in residence
- Accompanies/drives student when student goes to the hospital; acts as the student's advocate; serves as the liaison between the hospital and the student/student's family
- Maintains student's confidential files and records
- Use a computer and various software applications
- Other duties as assigned

Working Environment

The physical demands of this job include; occasional lifting, carrying, pushing, and/or pulling; some stooping, kneeling, crouching, and/or crawling; and significant finger dexterity. This job is performed under conditions with exposure to risk of injury and/or illness.
